How to create a MyMedicare.gov account

You can print this page as a guide or follow along with step-by-step instructions with this handout.

- 1.** Go to MyMedicare.gov and click on Create an account now.
- 2.** Next screen click OK
- 3.** Input the information from your Medicare card exactly how it appears
- 4.** Next screen click OK
- 5.** Input your basic information
- 6.** Create a Username and Password. Write down your username and password and put it in a place you'll remember. Also, you'll need to answer a secret question. Remember your answer and write it down.
- 7.** Next, Log in
- 8.** The following screen is your account dashboard. It will show your current account information. Scroll down until you see 6 boxes. Click on "Update/Print My Drugs" box.
- 9.** Confirm your drug list or create your drug list using the button "Add recently filled drugs" or "Add a drug."
- 10.** Review your drug list, watch for duplicates. If any prescriptions are missing, you can add them on the next page.
- 11.** After editing or adding drugs, click "Done Adding Drugs" or "OK"
- 12.** Confirm your updated drug list by clicking "Done Adding Drugs"
- 13.** Congratulations! You now have your MyMedicare.gov account.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) collects information from Medicare beneficiaries to set up a secure account on Medicare.gov and provide personalized Medicare information to the beneficiary. 1851(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395w-21(d)) authorizes CMS to provide information and coverage options to Medicare beneficiaries on an internet site.

CMS may use and disclose beneficiaries information as specified in the System of Records Notice (SORN) "1-800 Medicare Choice (HELPLINE)," System No. 09-70-0535, 66 FR 16679, March 27, 2001 and as permitted by the Privacy Act of 1974. Providing the requested information is voluntary; however, failure to provide this information may prevent creating an account.

Check your red, white and blue Medicare card. Enter your Medicare Number as it appears on your Medicare card, with or without dashes. (The letters B, I, L, O, S, and Z are not used in Medicare numbers.)

Username guidelines

Do's

- Must be 8-30 characters long with no spaces
- Can have letters, numbers, and these special characters: @ ! . - _ \$
- Must have at least 4 letters
- Can be your email address

Don'ts

- Can't include your Medicare Number or Social Security number
- Can't be the same as your password
- Can't have a special character as the first or last character

Password guidelines

Do's

- Must be 8-16 characters long
- Must have at least 1 letter
- Must have at least 1 number
- Must have 1 or more of only these special characters: @ ! \$ % ^ * ()
- Must be different from your last 6 passwords

Don'ts

- Can't contain your username
- Can't include your Medicare Number or Social Security number
